*The route to qualification is via 11 on-line modules with MCQs.*



*Following successful completion of these you can attend an online webinar followed*

*by a practical training day at the NRC which will cover foreign body removal, GAT, GAT calibration and advanced slit lamp techniques. After some further self-led practice you can attend the NRC for the qualifying OSCEs. Full support is provided throughout the course and at the present time HEE funding is available. (subject to a £35 administration fee).*
